DESCRIPTION: To continue the development permitted by permission MW.0089/14 (open storage within class B8) to amend condition 8 to limit the storage uses permitted to palleted natural stone

products only

LOCATION: Hornton Grounds Quarry, Hornton, Banbury, OX15 6HH

Thank you for consulting the Cotswolds Conservation Board ('the Board') on this proposed development, which would be located within the setting of the Cotswolds National Landscape.¹

In reaching its planning decision, the local planning authority (LPA) has a statutory duty to have regard to the purpose of conserving and enhancing the natural beauty of the National Landscape.² The Board recommends that, in fulfilling this 'duty of regard', the LPA should: (i) ensure that planning decisions are consistent with relevant national and local planning policy and guidance; and (ii) take into account the following Board publications:

- Cotswolds Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty (AONB) Management Plan 2018-2023 (link);
- Cotswolds AONB Landscape Character Assessment (<u>link</u>) particularly, in this instance, with regards to Landscape Character Type (LCT) 6 (Ironstone Hills and Valleys) from which the site can potentially be viewed.
- Cotswolds AONB Landscape Strategy and Guidelines (<u>link</u>) particularly, in this instance, with regards to LCT 6 (<u>link</u>) including Section 6.6;
- Cotswolds AONB Local Distinctiveness and Landscape Change (link); and
- Cotswolds Conservation Board Position Statements (<u>link</u>) particularly, in this instance, with regards to the Development in the Setting of the AONB (<u>link</u>) and the Tranquillity Position Statement (<u>link</u>).

This application proposes to amend condition 8 of permission MW.0089/14 to restrict the material which is permitted to be stored on site to palleted natural stone products only. The condition currently allows any storage that falls within B8, subject to satisfactory details of surfacing and drainage being submitted and approved.

The proposed change to the condition would therefore result in a more limited storage use than what is currently permitted. This may reduce the likelihood of adverse impacts on landscape amenity associated with the storage use in the future. As such the Board **does not object** to this application.
