**APPEAL REF:** 3307537

**DESCRIPTION:** i) Without planning permission, unauthorised engineering works to reprofile land to facilitate, without planning permission, the erection of a two-storey, semi-subterranean building. ii) Without planning permission, unauthorised engineering works to reprofile and level land to form a hardstanding area. iii) Without planning permission, the unauthorised formation of an access track to the hardstanding.

LOCATION: Midford Castle, Access Road to Midford Castle, Midford, Bath

Bath & North East Somerset Council has informed the Cotswold Conservation Board ('the Board') of the applicant's appeal against the Council's enforcement notice relating to the alleged development referred to above at the Midford Castle Estate, which is located within the Cotswolds National Landscape<sup>1</sup>.

We understand that the appellant has appealed against the notice on a number of grounds, including that planning permission should be granted for what is alleged in the notice. We also understand that in the event of this appeal being allowed, it is open to the Inspector to grant planning permission for the alleged development.

Whilst there are no details of the alleged development available online, the Board wishes to highlight that, in reaching a decision on this appeal, the Inspector has a statutory duty to have regard to the purpose of conserving and enhancing the natural beauty of the National Landscape.<sup>2</sup> The Board respectfully recommends that, in fulfilling this 'duty of regard', the Inspector should: (i) ensure that planning decisions are consistent with relevant national and local planning policy and guidance; and (ii) take into account the following Board publications:

- Cotswolds Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty (AONB) Management Plan 2018-2023 (link);
- Cotswolds AONB Landscape Character Assessment (<u>link</u>) particularly, in this instance, with regards to Landscape Character Type (LCT) 4 (Enclosed Limestone Valley);
- Cotswolds AONB Landscape Strategy and Guidelines (<u>link</u>) particularly, in this instance, with regards to LCT 4 (<u>link</u>), including Section 4.2;
- Cotswolds AONB Local Distinctiveness and Landscape Change (link); and
- Cotswolds Conservation Board Position Statements (<u>link</u>) particularly, in this instance, with regards to the Dark Skies and Artificial Light Position Statement (<u>link</u>) and its appendices (<u>link</u> 1, <u>link</u> 2, <u>now updated in 2021, link</u> 3)
