LOCATION: Telecommunications Apparatus, Alder Way, Chalford, Stroud

The above planning application, which is for a development that would be located within the Cotswolds National Landscape¹, has been brought to the attention of the Cotswolds Conservation Board.

In reaching its planning decision, the local planning authority (LPA) has a statutory duty to have regard to the purpose of conserving and enhancing the natural beauty of the National Landscape.² The Board recommends that, in fulfilling this 'duty of regard', the LPA should: (i) ensure that planning decisions are consistent with relevant national and local planning policy and guidance; and (ii) take into account the following Board publications³:

- Cotswolds Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty (AONB) Management Plan 2018-2023 (<u>link</u>), in particular Policy CE1;
- Cotswolds AONB Landscape Character Assessment (<u>link</u>) particularly, in this instance, with regards to Landscape Character Types (LCT) 7 (High Wold) which the site lies within and 5 (Settled Valley), 8 (High Wold Valley) and 9 (High Wold Dip Slope) from which the proposed mast may potentially be visible;
- Cotswolds AONB Landscape Strategy and Guidelines (<u>link</u>) particularly, in this instance, with regards to LCT 7 (<u>link</u>) including Section 7.9, LCT 5 (<u>link</u>) including Section 5.5, LCT 8 (<u>link</u>) including Section 8.5 and LCT 9 (<u>link</u>), including Section 9.10;
- Cotswolds AONB Local Distinctiveness and Landscape Change (link); and
- Cotswolds Conservation Board Position Statements (<u>link</u>), particularly in this instance with regards to the Telecommunications and the Rural Economy Position Statement (<u>link</u>).
