LOCATION: Land Adjacent Wheelwright Gardens, Old Road, Long Compton

Thank you for consulting the Cotswolds National Landscape Board¹ on this proposed development, which would be located within the Cotswolds National Landscape².

In reaching its planning decision, the local planning authority (LPA) has a statutory duty to have regard to the purpose of conserving and enhancing the natural beauty of the National Landscape.³ The Board recommends that, in fulfilling this 'duty of regard', the LPA should: (i) ensure that planning decisions are consistent with relevant national and local planning policy and guidance; and (ii) take into account the following Board publications⁴:

- Cotswolds Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty (AONB) Management Plan 2018-2023 (link);
- Cotswolds AONB Landscape Character Assessment (<u>link</u>) particularly, in this instance, with regards to Landscape Character Types (LCT) 17 (Pastoral Lowland Vale) where the site is located and LCTs 15 (Farmed Slopes) and 7 (High Wold) from which the site is potentially visible;
- Cotswolds AONB Landscape Strategy and Guidelines (<u>link</u>) particularly, in this instance, with regards to LCT 17 (<u>link</u>) including Section 17.1, LCT 15 (<u>link</u>) including Section 15.1 and LCT 7 (<u>link</u>);
- Cotswolds AONB Local Distinctiveness and Landscape Change (<u>link</u>) particularly, in this instance, with regards to Chapter 4 (The Built Environment) (<u>link</u>); and
- Cotswolds Conservation Board Position Statements (<u>link</u>) in particular the Dark Skies and Artificial Light Position Statement (<u>link</u>) and its appendices (<u>link 1</u>, <u>link 2</u>, <u>link 3</u>).

- 1) Cotswolds National Landscape is the new name for the Cotswolds Areas of Outstanding Natural Beauty (AONB). The new name takes forward one of the proposals of the Government-commissioned 'Landscapes Review' to rename AONBs as 'National Landscapes'. This change reflects the national importance of AONBs and the fact that they are safeguarded, in the national interest, for nature, people, business and culture.
- 2) The name used for the organisation associated with the AONB designation is the Cotswolds National Landscape Board. At times this is abbreviated to National Landscape Board or The Board. The legal name of the organisation remains the Cotswolds Conservation Board but this name is no longer used in most circumstances.
