Please include the Cotswolds National Landscape logo, and The National Lottery Heritage Fund acknowledgement stamp and statement, on the following: **social media posts** and **press releases** such as announcements of project funding and significant milestones; **digital material** such as webpages, blogs, educational materials, and newsletters; **printed material** such as posters, flyers, brochures, guides/maps; **physical signage** for buildings, structures or outdoor spaces, and wayfinding signage; and **exhibitions or artefact displays**.
